Our children put up an impromptu show of Dance, Yoga and Karate and wowed our guests

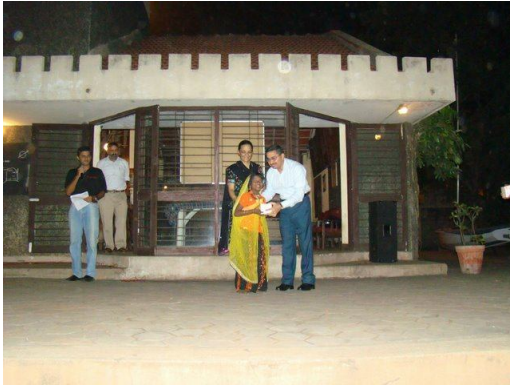


Dr E C Devraj from USA (1st from left) and Mr Narayan Khushalani (4th from left) and friends visited our school and showered their love and warmth on our children.

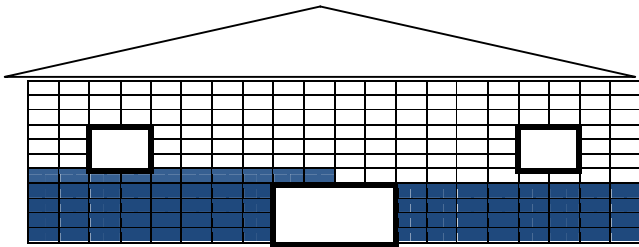

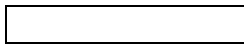
