## 2 Trust Children Overview

Trust Children ([www.trustchildren.org](http://www.trustchildren.org)) is a registered public charity in India that provides FREE education to underprivileged children through its school called Gurukulam in Panayur Village, Chennai, India. Started by Capt. Nandkumar, Managing Trustee, the Trust is run by a group of young adults who are based globally and share a common vision and mission.

### Our Vision

- To break the “poverty - manual labour” cycle of the economically underprivileged through education.
- To nurture ethical human beings of grandeur and strength; intelligence tempered by humility, and strength tempered by love.

### Our Mission

- To provide free education and sponsorship to economically underprivileged children until they complete a professional or vocational course through our School “Gurukulam”.
- To nurture inner and outer strength in the child through martial arts, yoga, meditation, and by teaching righteous living through “How to Live” classes and “Story Telling”.

### Quick Facts

- Started in 2004 with 34 children, Gurukulam School currently has 182 children in classes LKG through VII Grade.
- All students are from an economically underprivileged background whose parents earn less than Rs. 100 (\$2 USD) per day.
- Gurukulam School provides their children with:
  - FREE education in English medium
  - FREE lunch & breakfast
  - FREE text books
  - FREE uniforms
  - FREE travel
  - FREE training in karate, Tai Chi, Yoga, and Meditation
  - FREE medical and dental check-up
  - “How to Live” moral classes and “Story Telling” classes
  - Other extra-curricular activities such as sports, dance, music, and painting, and more for their overall development.
- Trust Children has pledged to support each Gurukulam Child until he/she completes a professional/vocational course.
